Code of Conduct

The students of Vidyavardhaka College of Engineering shall strictly adhere to the below mentioned code of conduct.

1. Ragging is a crime. Any student found involved in this act will be punished as per the law.
2. Wearing of ID cards in the campus is mandatory.
3. Mobile phones should be in off mode in lecture halls and labs. Violation of this will lead to confiscation of the mobile phone.
4. The Institute shall not be responsible for mobile phones; cash or any other items lost or left behind in the College premises.
5. The desks and other furniture should not be defaced by writing names and obscene remarks on them or even by drawing on them with pens, knives and other sharp instruments.
6. Students should come to the college in decent and presentable attire.
7. Vehicles should be parked in the parking area.
8. Use of abusive/filthy language and gestures is strictly prohibited.
9. Maintain discipline when you are in the other college, representing VVCE for placement process or for participating in the co-curricular/extracurricular activities or for any other reasons.
10. During industrial tour strictly follow the guidelines issued by the college authority.
11. Arranging get together outside the college which may spoil the reputation of the dept/college is strictly prohibited.
12. Smoking, chewing of tobacco, consumption of alcohol and use of drugs are strictly prohibited.
13. Misuse of electronic/internet media (SMS, MMS, email, social network sites etc) is strictly prohibited.
14. Mass bunking of classes is strictly prohibited. Any violation will attract a fine of Rs.100/- per student per hour.
