Pursuant to the aforesaid Academic Council Resolution in the 3rd Academic Council Meeting and Governing Body Resolution in the 3rd Governing Body Meeting, the following amendments to 'Academic Regulations Governing the Degree of Undergraduate and Postgraduate Programmes of VVCE-2020' are notified.



	<p>(B) How to Apply?</p> <p>(i) Student must pay the prescribed fee, fill the 'Revaluation Form' and submit the duly signed application form along with the fee paid receipt to office of COE by appearing in person before the last date mentioned.</p> <p>(ii) At the time of submitting application, student will produce the proof of his/her identity to the concerned authorities</p> <p>(iii) Applications received after the last date and applications not duly signed and submitted by the person seeking Revaluation will not be considered.</p> <p>(C) Process: Revaluation will be done by a senior faculty from the panel of examiners. The existing marks will not be disclosed to the examiners during Revaluation.</p> <p>(D) Revaluation Marks: The better of the first evaluation and revaluation marks will be awarded as the final marks after the revaluation.</p>
